General Information/Instructions
For a 2019 Tandem Dump Truck

- 1) All quotes shall be placed in a sealed envelope and marked “2019 Tandem Dump Truck Chassis”.
Mail quotes to: Jeannette Atkinson, Clerk/Treasurer, Town of Wascott, PO Box 159, Wascott, WI 54890.
Quotes are due by Noon, Friday, February 23, 2018. Opening of Quotes will take place at a Special Town Board Meeting on Friday, February 23 at 12:30 p.m.
Award of quotes will take place at the Regular Town Board Meeting to be held on Tuesday, March 6, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. at the Wascott Town Hall.
- 1) All equipment furnished under this spec *shall* be new, unused, and from current production. The word “*shall*” indicates a mandatory requirement (no deviations). All other requirements are approximate. Deviations from approximate specifications considered “minor” by the Highway Foreman will be allowed. Deviations considered “major” will not be allowed. The determination of the Highway Foreman will be based upon whether or not the deviation is counter to the intent of the spec and *shall* be final.
 - 2) The dealer *shall* be responsible for furnishing the units to the Town appointed body vendor. The dealer can use central Wisconsin as the location of the appointed body vendor. If the body vendor chooses to sub-contract painting, rust-proofing, or the installation of any accessories, the vendor *shall* be responsible for coordinating the work with the sub-contractor to insure both continuity and compliance to this spec. The Town reserves the right to reject quotes from dealers/vendors who are not factory authorized parts and service dealers.
 - 3) The quote must comply with all material requirements of the invitation and specifications. The Town of Wascott reserves the right to reject any quote determined to be nonresponsive. Further, the Town of Wascott reserves the right to reject any or all quotes, or any portion of quote, as determined to be in the best interest of the Town.
 - 4) Manufacturer’s full and detailed cuts and specs for the equipment quoted must be attached.
 - 5) The date on or before which the equipment will be delivered, *must* be stated on the quote. This stated date of delivery *shall* be part of the quote and may be used in evaluating quotes.
 - 6) The body vendor *shall* be responsible for delivering the equipment to the Town of Wascott
 - 7) If the equipment is not delivered on or before the specified date, complete and ready for use, there will be a \$50.00 per calendar day charge deducted from the final payment for each day after this date for late delivery charge. The forfeiture shall not apply if the late delivery is due to items beyond the control of the vendor submitting the primary quotation – fire, strike, war, government prohibition, requisition by government of essential property or preferential government orders.
 - 8) All quotations *shall* be firm for at least 45 days from proposal opening date.
A written notice of award will be given to the successful bidder. The bidder(s) are required to execute the public contract and furnish required certificates of insurance within ten (10) calendar days from the date of the notice of award.
 - 9) Payment shall be made within 30 days of receipt of a properly completed invoice or receipt and acceptance of the product or service.
