

TOWN OF WASCOTT PROCEDURES TO COMBAT COVID-19

The Wascott Town Board has adopted CDC guidelines for all Town owned property. This includes the following recommendations:

- Stay home when sick or if you have been exposed to anyone testing positive or who has symptoms within the past 14 days.
- Stay at least 6 feet apart from people who are not from your household – in both indoor and outdoor spaces.
- Wear cloth face coverings in public settings, especially when it is difficult to maintain social distancing measures.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water and/or use hand sanitizer, especially if you have been in a public place; and after coughing, sneezing or blowing your nose.

In addition, any directives or guidelines implemented by Douglas County or the State of Wisconsin will be adhered to. CDC and other guidelines will be updated as needed.
